Learning Targets:

- I can write a poem using poetic techniques (figurative language, and graphic elements).
- I can analyze the importance of graphical elements to the meaning of a poem.
- I can plan and develop a first draft that includes important poetic techniques such as figurative language, graphic elements, and/or theme.
- I can revise a draft to include precise and vivid word choice and imagery.
- I can use poetic techniques purposely to enhance the meaning of my poem.
- I can evaluate feedback from others to revise and edit my draft.

HOW TO PUBLISH YOUR FINAL COPY:

You will be using the app CANVA to make a digital image of your poem. Read the instructions below to design your digital poem. Look at the examples on the following page to get some creative inspiration.

1. Download Canva from self service.
2. Create an account using your school email and password.
3. Sign in if needed.
4. Pick a design.
5. Pick a background images that suits the tone and mood of your poem.
*you may also search for a background image on the internet and save it on your camera roll to be uploaded - just make sure it is big enough, and doesn't come out blurry!
6. Place your background image and type out your poem over it.
7. Download it to your camera roll and publish it as a post on your blog.

TIPS:

- *If your background image is dark, use a light or white colored font.
- *Make sure your font and color is able to be read.
- *Choose a design big enough to be printed.
